## All About

- a. A variety of fonts and formatting;
- b. Photos;
- c. A drawing created on the computer;

- d. A graph
- e. A table
- f. A sound file, or movie

When your document is finished, we will show it to the whole class if you wish. This will allow us to give helpful suggestions and accolades, and give ideas to others to improve their documents.

## Here are some tips that will make the experience more pleasant and fruitful:

- The FIRST thing you do after you open a new document is to decide what its name is going to be, and where you are going to store it;
- Save your document <u>often</u>, and back it up somewhere at the end of each work session.
- Don't worry too much about formatting while you are gathering and inputing data and text. Just kind of smoosh it all in...format it later. This is especially true during the research phase.
- When you are working in the word processor, don't worry too much about perfect grammar and spelling...just get the information and ideas down! You can clean it up later.
- Use the word processor formatting functions as much as possible. Resist the temptation to manually format everything. It makes re-formatting and editing a headache if you do!
